Rules and Conditions of Play

1. Constituent of a tie
 - 1.1. [Men's Team or Women's Team] Each tie consists of 4 matches of men or women doubles.
 - 1.1.1. Each team decides their four doubles pairings and ranks the pairings according to the strength prior to the start of a tie. The 1st ranked pair of each team plays against each other, and then other ranked pairings follow suit.
 - 1.1.2. Each player must play with different partners if he/she plays two matches in a tie. The team may change their pairings in another tie.
 - 1.1.3. One player may play two consecutive matches in a tie. Up to 5-minute break between the two consecutive matches may be allowed.
 - 1.2. [Mixed Team only] Each tie consists of 2 matches of mixed doubles, 1 match of women's doubles and 2 matches of men's doubles.
 - 1.2.1. Each team must decide on the doubles pairings prior to the start of each tie. The team may change their pairings in another tie.
 - 1.2.2. A player can play no more than one mixed doubles in a tie.
 - 1.2.3. The order of play in each tie should be as follow, with the first and second ranked doubles playing the respective same ranked pairing of the opposing team in each match:
 - Men's Doubles – first ranked
 - Women's Doubles
 - Men's Doubles – second ranked
 - Mixed Doubles – first ranked
 - Mixed Doubles – second ranked
 - 1.3. Each player is allowed to compete in no more than 2 matches per tie.
 - 1.4. Each tie will be 90-110 minutes in duration. Any unfinished game will cease at the sound of the finishing bell and the score points are recorded accordingly.
 - 1.5. One-minute on court warm-up time is allowed per match. One-minute interval is allowed between 2 games or within 1 game.
2. Scoring
 - 2.1. A round robin is made for a pool of maximum 4 teams in each event. Teams will oppose each of the other teams in a round robin series. Each match comprises of 2 games of 21 points or 15 points, or 1 game of 30 points, with no setting. If there are more than 4 teams registering for an event, a modified round robin series may be established, depending on the number of teams.
 - 2.2. The result of each tie shall be decided on the number of games won - the team winning the greater number of games shall be declared the winner. The tie winner will be awarded with 2 match points. Should teams win the same number of games, each team will gain 1 match point. The tie loser will have zero match point.
 - 2.3. The team winning the highest total match points in the pool shall be the winner. If two teams have won the same total match points, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher. If the tie between them is a draw, then the winner is decided by the difference between total points won and total points lost in the tie.
 - 2.3.1. If three or more teams have won the same total match points, ranking will be established by the difference between total games won and total games lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this still leaves two teams equal, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher.
 - 2.3.2. If three or more teams are still equal, ranking will be established by the difference between total points won and total points lost, with greater difference ranked higher. If this still leaves two teams equal, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher.
 - 2.3.3. If three or more teams are still equal, then ranking will be established by drawing lots.
3. Conditions
 - 3.1. All players participating in the tournament will be deemed to have read and accepted the conditions and rules under which the tournament events are to be conducted.
 - 3.2. The Tournament Organiser (Sydney Central Badminton Association) will NOT be responsible for any injury sustained, at any time, by any player or official arising from their participation in this Tournament. Players agree to indemnify the Tournament Organiser, its officers and agents against all claims, demands, actions and liabilities of any kind (other than due to wilful negligence) arising in the course of participating in the Tournament.
 - 3.3. Players must wear appropriate badminton attire, including non-marking shoes, when on court and at all times in the hall.
 - 3.4. A briefing to team captains shall be made 30 minutes prior to the start of the events. All events will start promptly at scheduled time. Players should have the warm up exercise well before the match starts.
 - 3.5. The Tournament Organiser reserves the right to cancel any event. Events of different grades may be combined if insufficient number of entries are received.
 - 3.6. Any alterations made to the competition schedule will be announced by the Referee. The Referee may disqualify any player not available to play at the scheduled time or when the match is officially called on.
 - 3.7. No refund of entry fee is available except for events cancelled by the Tournament Organiser.
 - 3.8. The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton adopted by the Badminton World Federation (BWF), subject to modifications by the Tournament Organiser/Referee.
 - 3.9. The Tournament Organiser/Referee reserves the right to disqualify any players, officials, and coach for any breach of regulations. Spectator may be requested by the tournament officials or venue management to leave the hall if his/her behaviour causes any disturbance to the players, tournament officials or other spectators.
 - 3.10. Players will be required to umpire and/or line judge some matches.
 - 3.11. The Tournament Organiser has the discretion to upgrade or reject a player's entry without specifying a reason to the player.
 - 3.12. The Tournament Organiser/Referee reserves the right to vary any conditions or rules.
 - 3.13. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Organiser is final.
