Course Preparation

Before you attend, please:

- Download the Shuttle Time App on your phone or tablet. You will need this on the day.

Accreditation

In addition to completing the one-day course, the following must be completed (preferably before the course):

- Australian Coaching base courses: <https://learning.ausport.gov.au/auth/login/>
 - Community Coaching General Principles online course
 - Play by the rules – Child Protection online course
 - Play by the rules – Harassment and Discrimination online course
- Obtain a Working with Vulnerable Person Card: https://www.accesscanberra.act.gov.au/app/answers/detail/a_id/1804/~/working-with-vulnerable-people-%28wwvp%29-registration
 - An application fee of \$135.00 applies to people who are employed to work with vulnerable people. Registration is free for volunteers, however if the volunteer also works in a regulated activity they are still required to pay the \$135.00 fee.
